

**Rector report:**

**Pantry updates:**

- The city wants us to add windows and remove a door. The increase in cost is getting us to a place of how much a stick frame would be. (Costs are approaching \$220k)
- We've been advised to go forward with the permit, and possibly revise it later
- We need to discern if it's possible that a wood frame structure would be a better fit for the church and pantry overall
- Tim Klevenger is the senior VP of Marketing for Onpoint, and he came up with a communication plan for us and will begin sending out tomorrow
