All services are confidential, voluntary, and free of charge.

We're staffed with paramedics, licensed mental health crisis workers, case managers, and peer support specialists.


We're dispatched as unarmed, trauma-informed first responders for non-life-threatening (but crisis-related) scenarios such as behavioral health crises and welfare check calls.
