

They will provide us with Narcan and other harm reduction supplies as well as information and training. Additionally, our own Zoe secured a grant (thank you Zoe!) to pay for a group of us to get Narcan training from another new partner, <u>The Everly Project</u>. Next, we will design a system to add this competency to our programs. More coming!!
